The instructor position is part-time (varied FTE), 9-month, fixed term Instructor position with the possibility of renewal at the discretion of the School Head. There is a potential for a full-time appointment for the 2021-2022 academic year depending upon the qualifications of the candidate and teaching needs. This position requires in-person and online instruction.
