The Dean will support an interdisciplinary curriculum and leverage the history of the College to grow the College's visibility.

The successful candidate will possess an earned Ph.D. or equivalent from an accredited university in engineering, engineering technology, or related discipline; a scholarship and teaching record that would support an appointment at the rank of professor; administrative experience in a higher education context; and scholarly research including refereed publications and funded grants. A commitment to supporting innovation and interdisciplinary growth is essential, as is a record of valuing instructional excellence at all levels and supporting faculty and student research. Prior experience with public and private fundraising is highly desired. The Dean will also possess strong interpersonal and communication skills; the ability to build partnerships with community leaders; and a commitment to collegial decision-making and working with a diverse population of students, staff and faculty.
