USS Olympia Tour

Interested in logistical marvels, ships, and historical artifacts? Imagine stepping back in time to the technology of the late 1800s to discover the functional realities of life as a sailor. Launched in 1892, the Cruiser Olympia (C-6) is the oldest steel warship afloat in the world! The tour will include the engine room and the rest of the ship. If time permits, there will be also be a tour of WWII era sub.

Ever wonder how that product in your online shopping cart gets from Amazon to you? Picture this: orange robots balancing towers of goods twirling in what looks like a choreographed dance across shiny concrete floors, miles of conveyor belts and ramps carrying inventory across the building, and shipping labels practically flying onto boxes, blown by puffs of air. On this hour-long tour, you will see each part of the process: inbound products, the stowing process, order picking, quality assurance and order packing.

IAC Session for Students and ASEM's Student Case Competition

During the past 12 years, students from Engineering Management Programs across the US compete in a professional case competition. Last year eight engineering management student teams representing seven institutions participated in this daylong event at the annual international conference. This year ten teams have expressed interest in participating. The event consists of a six-hour analysis of an engineering management case study followed by a professional presentation to a panel of judges. The judges rank the presentation based upon depth of analysis, quality of the presentation and soundness of final recommendations. The highest scoring team is recognized at the awards banquet. This year marks the first international team participating in the competition. The presentations are open to all conference attendees.

Participating students benefit from performance evaluations by senior level engineering managers and faculty in the application of tools and techniques taught in the curriculum to a real-life engineering management situation. They learn from a time sensitive event leading a team to showcase their institutions ability to pass on leadership, critical thinking, problem solving, and teamwork skills; critical in the job market and life. Secondary benefits include professional networking, a resume building event and an employer interview topic providing an example that professional skills have been demonstrated and evaluated.
